The Responsive Reading: Psalm 89:1-8


- I will sing of the steadfast love of the LORD, forever; with my mouth I will make known your faithfulness to all generations.


Gospel Reading: Luke 2:33-40

And his father and his mother marveled at what was said about him. ³⁴ And Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, "Behold, this child is appointed for the fall and rising of many in Israel, and for a sign



that is opposed ³⁵ (and a sword will pierce through your own soul also), so that thoughts from many hearts may be revealed." ³⁶ And there was a prophetess, Anna, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was advanced in years, having lived with her husband seven years from when she was a virgin, ³⁷ and then as a widow until she was eighty-four. She did not depart from the temple, worshiping with fasting and prayer night and day. ³⁸ And coming up at that very hour she began to give thanks to God and to speak of him to all who were waiting for the redemption of Jerusalem. ³⁹ And when they had performed everything according to the Law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. ⁴⁰ And the child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom. And the favor of God was upon him.



ROBERT CAVANAUGH—WITH THE LORD: As you all know by now, Robert (Bob) Cavanaugh was murdered on Christmas Eve at his trailer park here in Madison Heights. Although not officially a member of Mt. Zion, Robert regularly attended our services for the past 4 years. Despite his sometimes-strained relationship with our congregation, Robert was a very friendly man, always teasing and joking with the kids and doing a lot to help care for the church property. Our little congregation is pretty shaken up by the news. I personally spent many hours counseling and visiting with Robert, directing him to God's Word and grace to help with his problems. He was a dear friend. I will miss him.

Eyewitnesses state that Robert was attempting to defend an abused dog when the man who was beating the dog turned on Robert and bludgeoned his head until he died. The suspect has been arrested and is awaiting charges pending the official cause of death from the medical examiner.

I think that the brutality of the murder combined with the fact that Robert was defending an animal, and it happened to be Christmas Eve have contributed to the story's national attention. However, most of the news reports that I have watched and read are perhaps a bit over-sensationalized and highly sentimental. Indeed, Robert was a kind and compassionate man. But he would be the first to tell you that he was a sinful man in need of a Savior. Thankfully, God blessed Robert with saving faith in his Savior and he trusted Him for forgiveness and salvation. So while we are shocked and horrified by his sudden death, we rejoice that Robert is now and forever with the Lord. Just as God promised, He has worked out even this tragedy for good--the eternal good of Robert's soul.

The funeral will be taking place here at Mt. Zion sometime in the New Year. Arrangements will be made after Robert's body is released from the medical examiner. Please keep Mt. Zion, Robert's family, and me in your prayers.
